About the Performers

Raised in a musical household, **IsabellaGrace Ebo** began playing harp in 2015 in Virginia Beach, VA. Upon moving to Texas in 2018, she continued her harp studies with Dr. Laura Brandenburg and later with Kela Walton through TCU's Music Preparatory program. In 2021 IsabellaGrace placed 1st in two competitions hosted by the Dallas chapter of the American Harp Society, and in early 2023 she was selected to be one of twelve TMEA All-State harpists. A high school senior, IsabellaGrace is in her second season with the Fort Worth Youth Orchestra and also enjoys playing harp in the orchestra at Christ Chapel Bible Church.

Lyndsey Walker is an active harpist and violist studying Music Education at TCU. Lyndsey started Suzuki at a young age cannot remember many days without music. Lyndsey's academic achievements include a BA degree in Biology awarded by TCU in 2021 and a Master of Science degree in Medical Physiology awarded by Case Western Reserve University in 2022. Lyndsey has performed with 2CELLOS, the San Angelo Symphony Orchestra, and Sherman Symphony Orchestra. Lyndsey's goal is to become an orchestra director after she graduates next fall, along with continuing to teach students privately.

Native Texan, **Kela Walton** enjoys a varied career as a harp instructor and freelance performer. An innovative educator, Kela serves on the faculty at Texas Christian University where she teaches harp to university and pre-college students, leads the TCU Harp Ensemble, and is the director of the TCU Summer Harp Workshop. Kela previously held positions with symphonies throughout the U.S. and can be heard on the 2019 release *Respighi: Roman Trilogy* for the Naxos label with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra.
