Artist Biography



Dr Rustam Shaykhutdinov is

head of the piano department at the Alfred Schnitke Institute of Music in Moscow. He has performed and judged throughout the world including Russia, Italy, Germany, South Korea, Spain, Denmark, Austria, the Czech Republic, and the United States. His students include more than 100 prize winners of Russian and International piano competitions. He has

published over 60 works on piano performance, theory

and methodology. Rustam was recognized by the Republic of Bashkortostan with a state award for the "Outstanding Achievement in Music Pedagogy" and the title "Honored Art Worker" of the Republic Bashkortostan. Rustam received "Teacher of the Year 2020" award from the International Scientific and Methodical Competition. Dr. Shaykhutdinov graduated from Gnessin's Music Academy in Moscow, Russia, where he studied with Maria Gambaryan, a pupil of legendary Konstantin Igumnov, Heinrich Neuhaus and Lev Oborin, whose tradition he is honoredto continue. Dr. Shayhutdinov is chairman of the jury for several piano competitions including "Konstantin Igumnov" (Lipetsk, Russia), "Alfred Schnitke" (Moscow, Russia), "Leopold&Mstislav Rostropovich's" (Orenburg, Russia), Premio Pianistico "Silvio Bengalli" (Italy), "Davorin Jenko" (Belgrade, Serbia), "Virtuosi per Musica di Pianoforte" (Usti nad Labem, Czech Republic), "Vazha Chachava" (Tbilisi, Georgia).
