

Welcome to the TCU Summer Music Institute 2025!

In preparation for the TCU Percussion Camp, I have provided information below to help make your check-in experience an easy one.

## **Building Addresses**

The TCU Music Center (MSC): 2900 West Lowden Street, Fort Worth Samuelson Residence Hall: 3202 Main Drive, Fort Worth

Overnight campers: If you are staying overnight in the residence hall, please check-in at Samuelson Hall first. Check-in begins at 8am. Park in visitor lot 6, cross Stadium Drive and pass through the BLUU arch. Samuelson is up the hill, the first dorm on the left. Look for the signs labeled "Music Dorm Check-in."

Overnight campers need to bring a sleeping bag (or bed linens, extra-long twin sheets), pillow, towel and toiletries. Then, drive over to the MSC for camp check-in.

Day campers: Day campers will check in at the MSC, beginning at 8:00am.

Music Center (MSC) parking is available in Lot 15, located on W Lowden Street. You can drop off your instruments at the MSC before parking. Please see the attached TCU Campus map with buildings circled in red and labeled parking lots.

If you plan to park a vehicle overnight, please alert one of the counselors at check-in, so you can receive a parking pass. Campers are not permitted to use their vehicles during the day/evening while at camp—only for arrival and departure purposes.

\*\*Please remember to bring your camper's completed Indemnity and Photo Release forms. Campers cannot participate until the completed and signed forms are handed in at check-in.
